Composition / Information on Ingredients

Propylene – Ethylene - Copolymer and mineral reinforcement, additives

Hazard Identification

The product is not classified as a dangerous preparation (EC).

First Aid Measures

Inhalation: none, But inhalation of dust may irritate the respiratory tract. Prolonged inhalation of high doses of decomposition products may give headache or irritation of the respiratory tract.

Skin Contact: none - hot and molten material on the skin should rapidly be cooled with cold water, after that medical attention should be obtained. - Do not pull off the material.

Eye Contact: removal as with other objects

Information for the physician: Material contains inert solids

Fire Fighting Measures

High concentration of dust should be avoided or stored separately as it forms a risk for dust explosion and burning.

The product burns, but is not classified as flammable.

Extinguishing agents: Water mist, dry chemicals, foam or carbon dioxide should be used.

Decomposition products: Unsuitable: using water in a jet
Water, CO₂, if oxygen is deficient also CO,
The products of combustion are irritating and partly toxic.
